The Foundation was established in May 2023 as a 501(C)3 Nonprofit Organization with the goal of providing scholarships to children of NTDA member employees as well as to trailer industry professionals who wish to further develop their technical skills by attending trade schools, vocational schools, colleges, or universities.

OUR MISSION

At the Foundation, our mission is simple yet profound: to make life easier for the families of trailer industry families. We believe that every individual deserves the opportunity to pursue their dreams and make a positive impact.



HOW THE FOUNDATION HELPS

Through the generosity of individual donors and corporate underwriters, the Foundation offers a range of scholarship opportunities to students pursuing higher education. Whether it's covering tuition fees, purchasing textbooks, or supporting living expenses, our scholarships provide crucial financial aid to deserving individuals, helping them navigate the journey to success.

Prior to establishing the Foundation in 2023, the NTDA awarded nearly a quarter million dollars in scholarships since 1998. That sounds like a lot of money, but there is still a tremendous need to support the families of semi-trailer industry professionals. To reach a broader range of students and employees wishing to pursue their education, we established a 501(c)(3) that is exempt from state and federal tax. This means more funds can go directly toward scholarships rather than to taxes. Likewise, your donations to the Foundation are tax-deductible. Donating to the Foundation allows individuals and companies alike to leave a lasting legacy by supporting education and helping students and employees achieve their academic and career goals.

This year, the Foundation awarded scholarships to graduating seniors. We also added a continuing education scholarship for employees of NTDA Dealer Members, **Dealer Branch Members, or Allied Members** seeking to further their education. Through scholarships provided by the Foundation, we strive to remove financial obstacles and enable students to focus on their studies and personal or professional growth. 
